1. Install and License PowerOLAP® Server *



You must be logged in as a user with Administrator or equivalent rights to install PowerOLAP® Software.

***IMPORTANT:** the following pages assume internet connectivity for the machine(s) on which you perform the PowerOLAP installation(s). If that is not the case, see **Offline Installation**, beginning page 1 - 20.

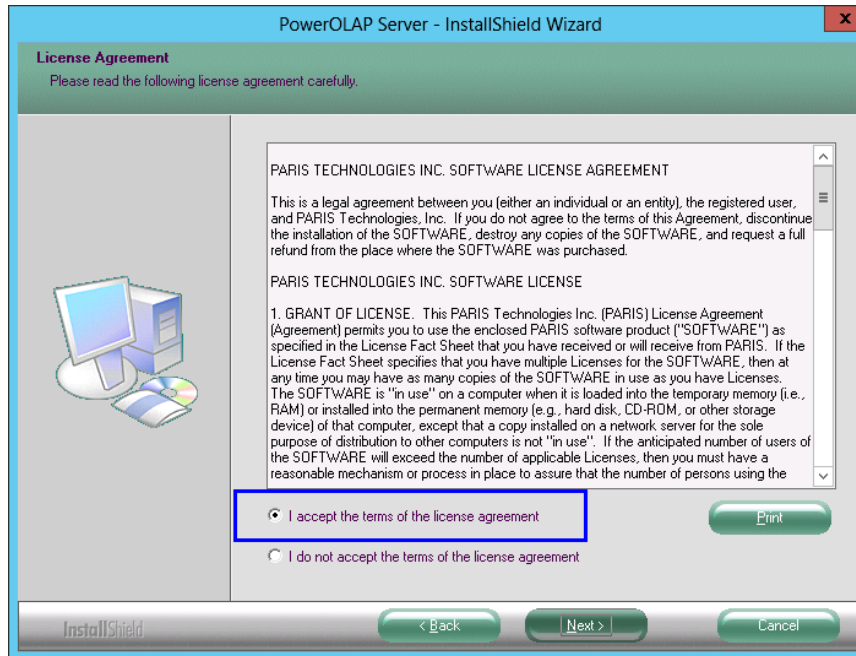

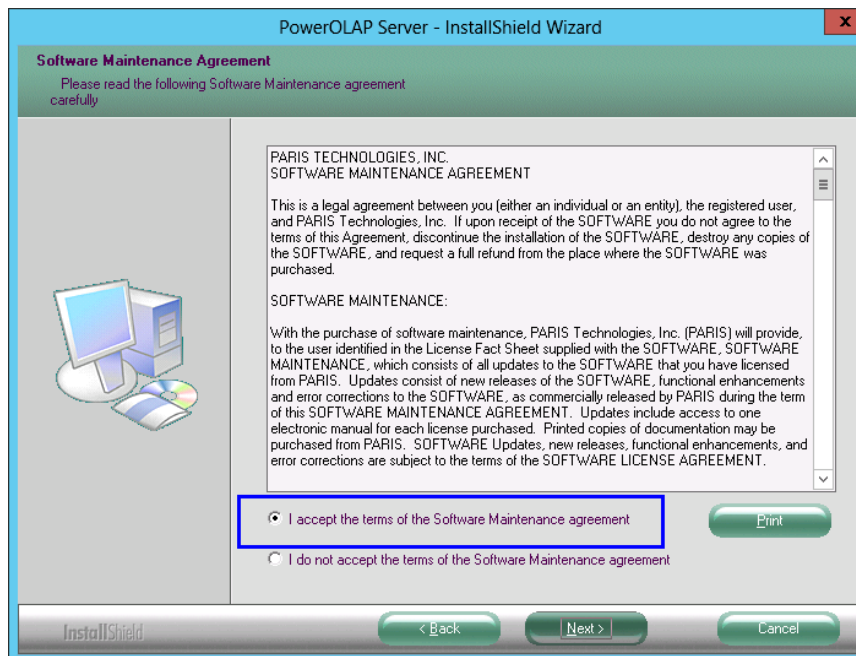
1.1.1 PowerOLAP® Server Software Installation

ACTION (You Do)	COMPUTER RESPONSE/Comments
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Locate the installation file for PowerOLAP®. 2. Run the Setup.exe. 	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Click Next at the Installation Welcome Screen. 	

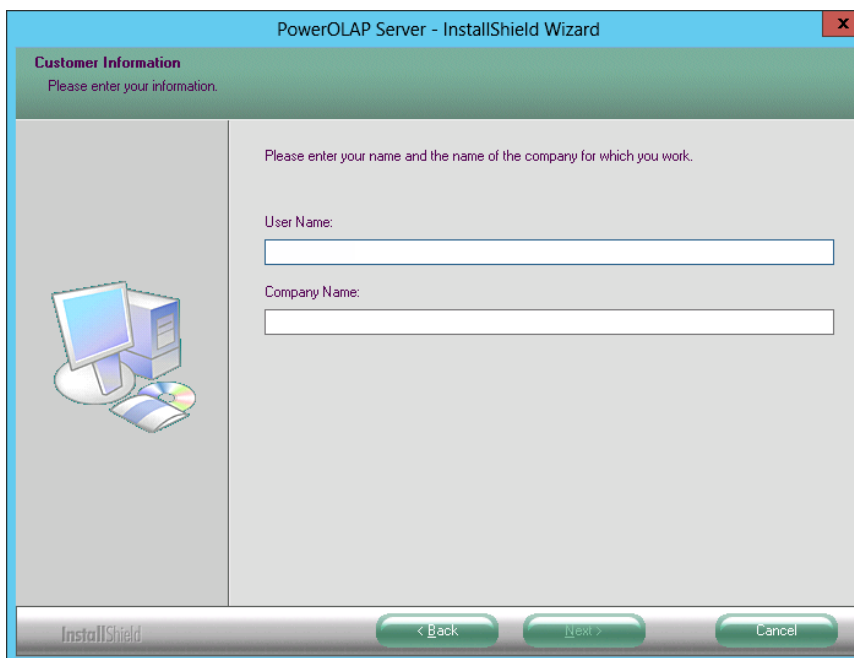
4. Read the License Agreement and select **I accept.**
5. Click **Next.**



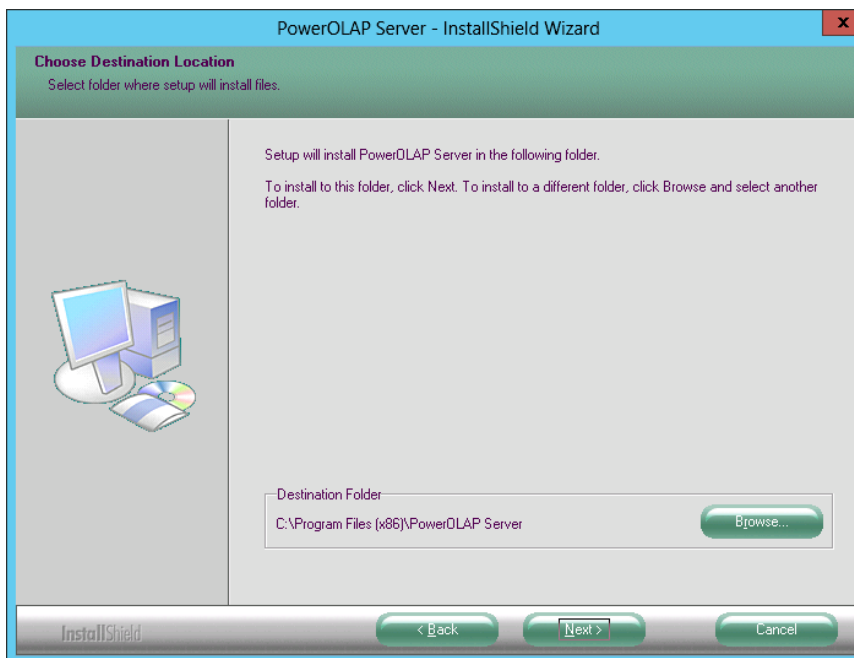
6. Read the Maintenance Agreement and select **I accept.**
7. Click **Next.**



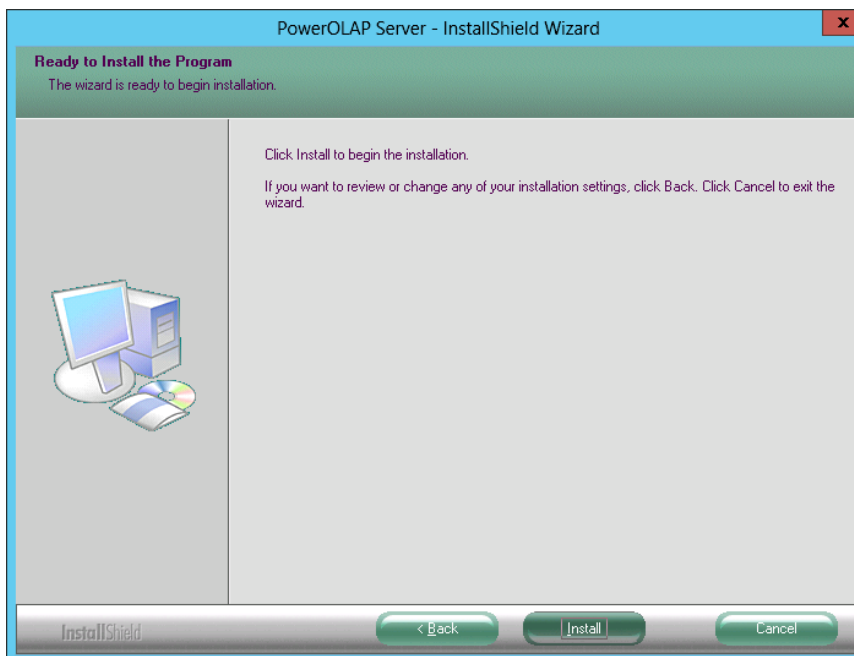
8. Enter the desired <User Name> and <Company Name> in the appropriate boxes.
9. Click **Next**.



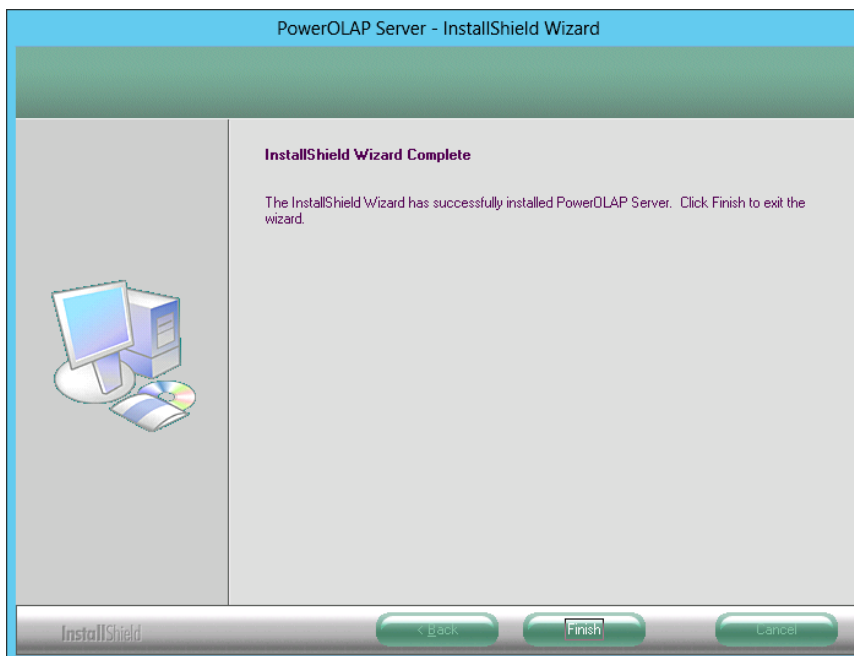
10. Click **Next** at the Destination Folder Screen.
11. **Accept** the default target directory.



12. Click **Install** to begin the installation.



13. Click **Finish** to close the installation.



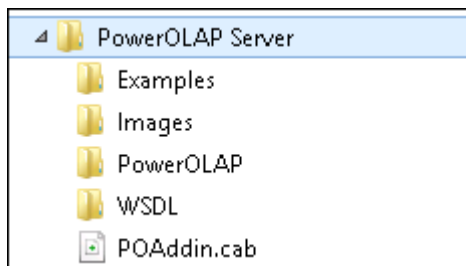
14. **Reboot** the computer.

This completes the Server installation.

1.1.1.1 Directories and Program Icons Created:

Server: The Server Installation creates C:\Program Files\PowerOLAP Server directory.

It has subdirectories as shown:





Note: The subdirectory PowerOLAP[®] contains the setup.exe file for the PowerOLAP[®] client installation. You can access this file directly on the local network, or access it online from the PowerOLAP[®] Web Server home page.

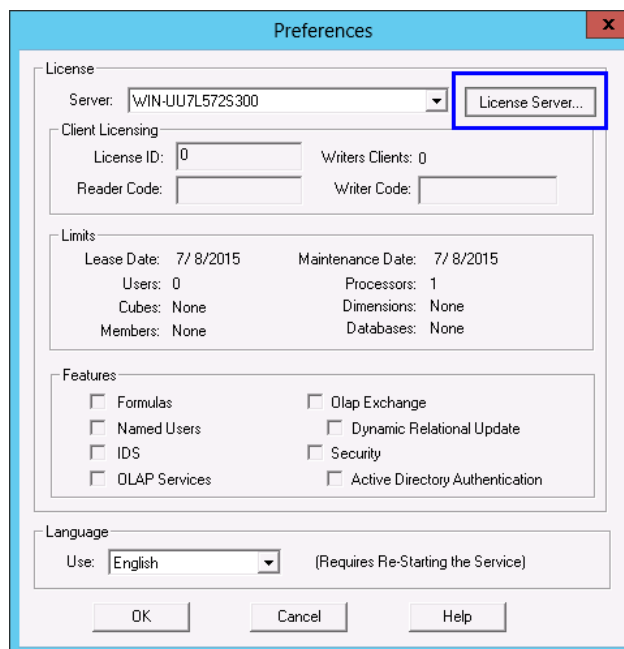
The installation also creates a menu item for the PowerOLAP[®] Server Control Program in the Windows Start Menu.

1. 1.2 Register and Activate the Server Software:

The Product Key or License ID is not required for installing the software, but after the installation, you will need to activate the software using a License ID and Password. This activates the product features and allows for permanent use of the software.

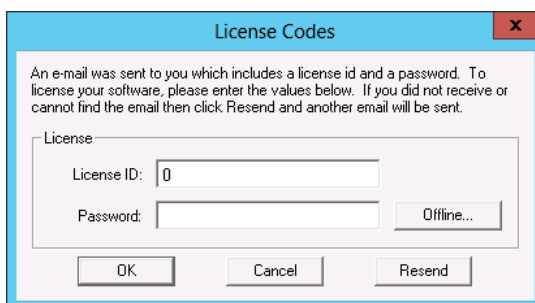
Activate your Software as follows:

ACTION (You Do)	COMPUTER RESPONSE/Comments
1. Start the PowerOLAP® Service Control program from the Start menu.	IMPORTANT: You must run/open the application as an administrator. To do this, right click on PowerOLAP® Service Control Program icon and select 'Run as administrator' option.
	
2. Start the Server .	The PowerOLAP Server status must be 'Running' to enable you to license it: click Start
	
3. Go to Edit menu and select Options command.	The Preferences dialog box appears.



4. Click the **License Server** button.
(boxed button in the preceding image, top right)

The **License Codes** window will appear.



5. Enter a valid **License ID** and **Password**
(reference your PowerOLAP licensing document)
6. Click **OK**.
7. **Restart** the PowerOLAP Server.

You will be prompted to stop and start the Server for the license to take effect.

This completes the PowerOLAP® Server installation and licensing.

2. Install and License PowerOLAP® Designer Client:



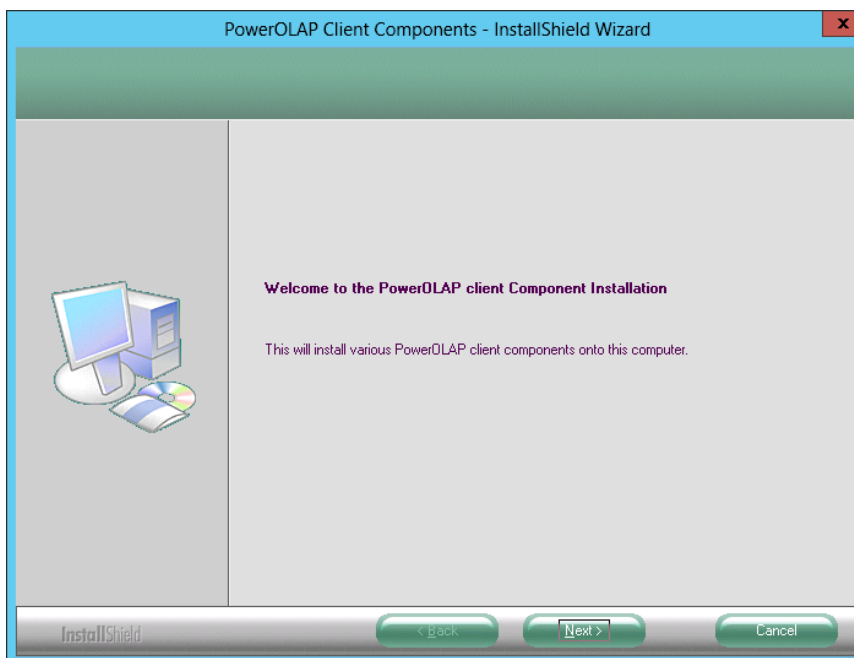

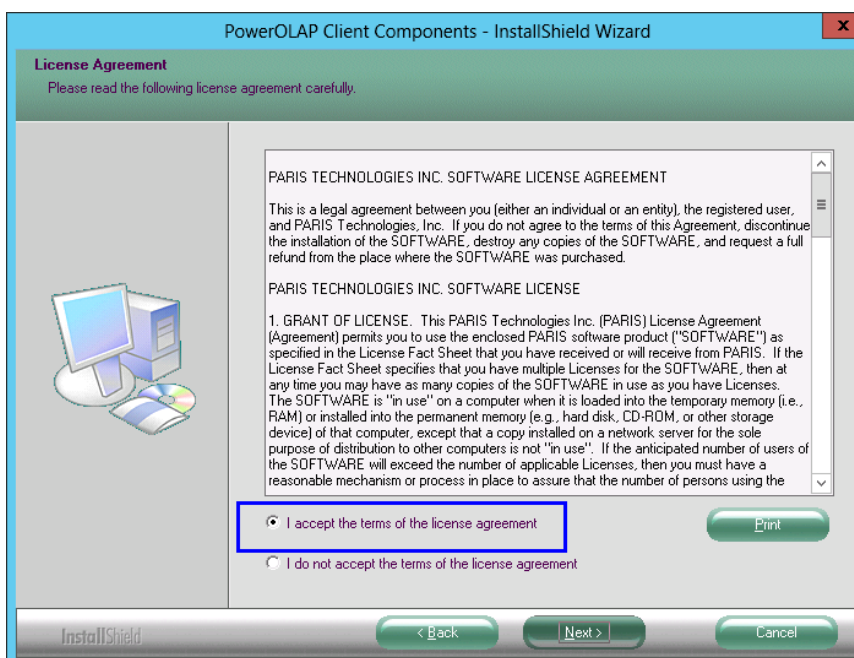
2.1.1 Designer Software Installation – Run the Setup.exe

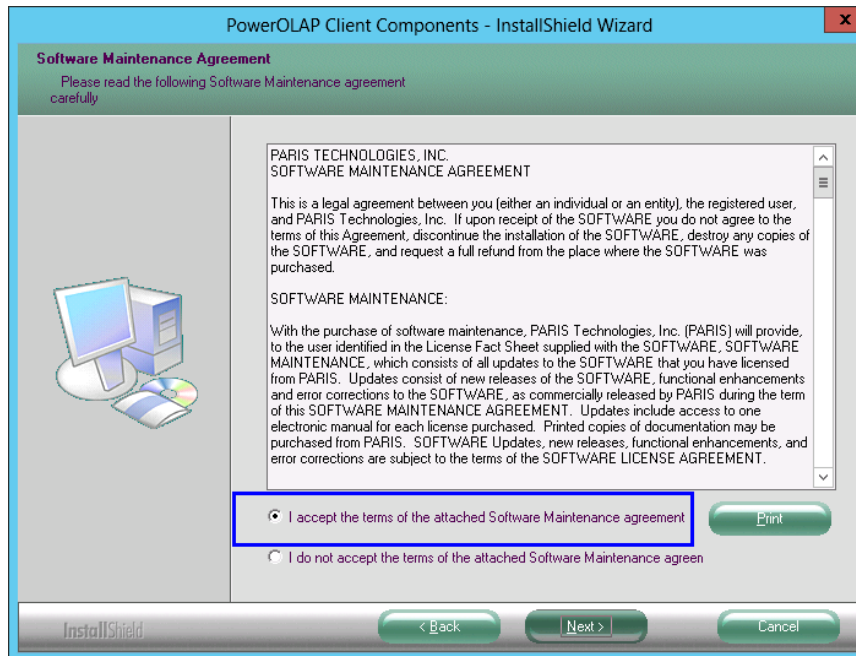
Note: The Designer Client works with local databases as well as server-based databases.

ACTION (You Do)	COMPUTER RESPONSE/Comments
1. Locate and run the Client Setup.exe installation file for PowerOLAP®.	IMPORTANT: You must run the application as an administrator. To do this, right click on PowerOLAP® installation file (setup.exe) and select 'Run as administrator' option.
	
2. Proceed to the Installation Welcome Screen, shown below, and click Next (see next image)	

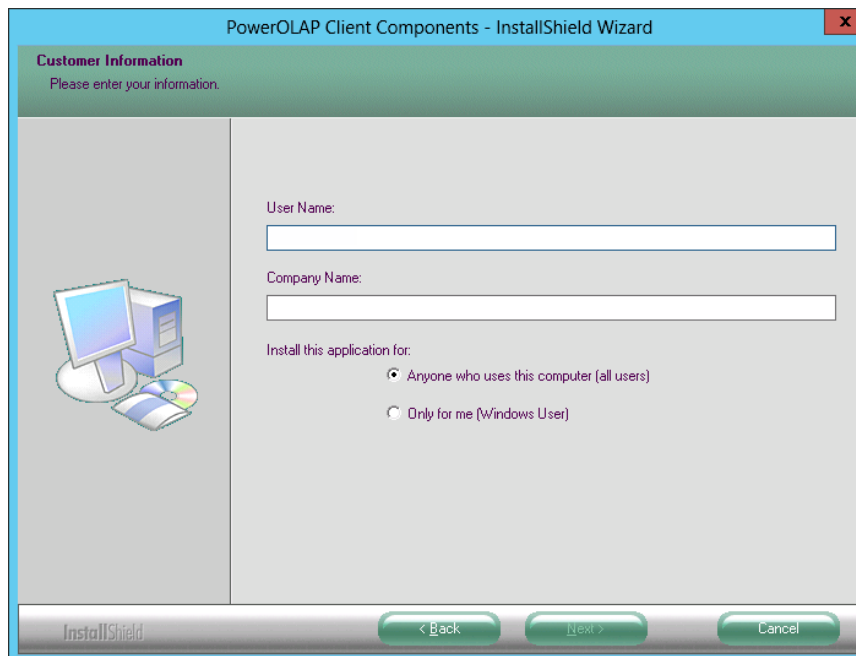


3. Read the License and Maintenance Agreement screens (following 2 images) and select **I Accept**. Click **Next**.





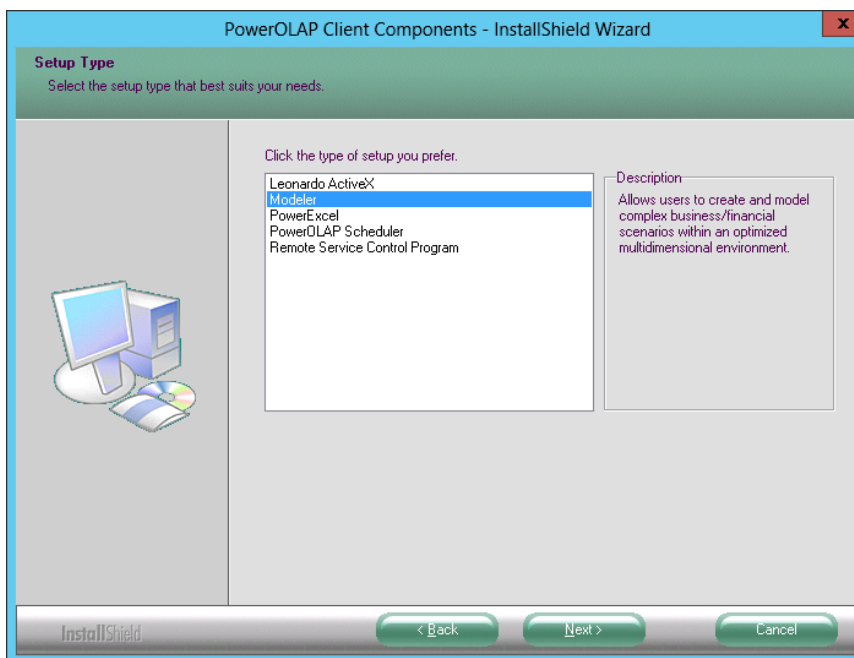
4. Enter the appropriate User Name and Company Name in the indicated boxes.
Note the button selections as shown below.



5. Click **Next**.

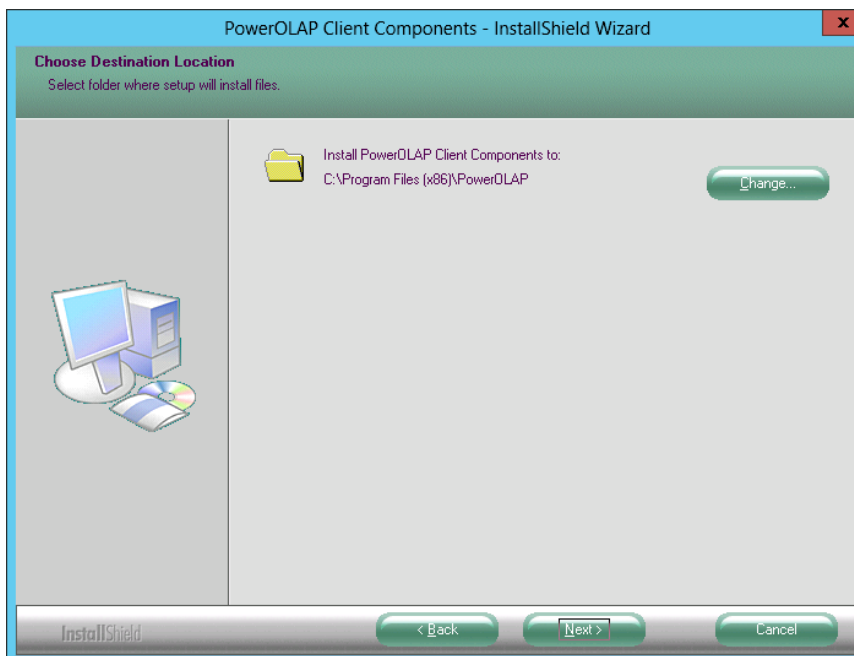
6. Leave the default selection at **Modeler**.

IMPORTANT: Do Not install any other selections at this time.

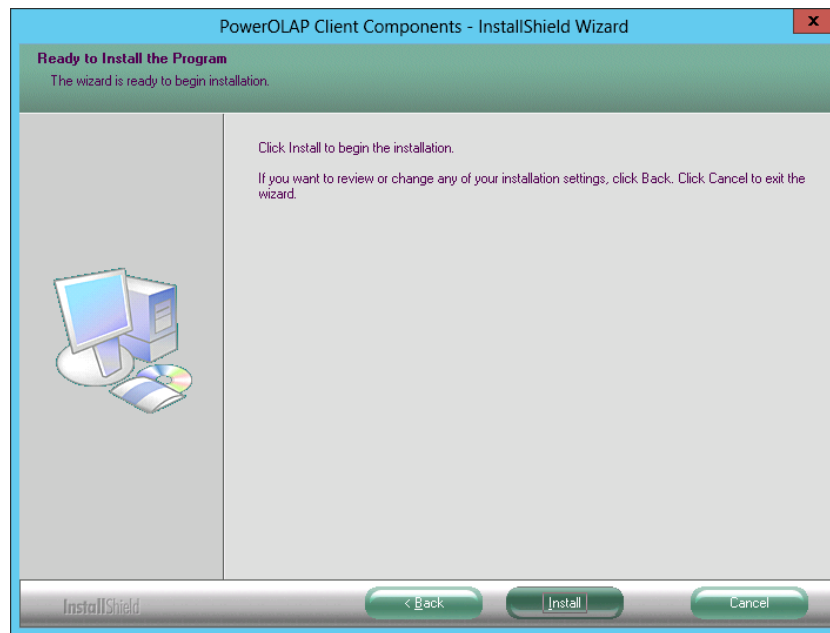


7. Click **Next**.

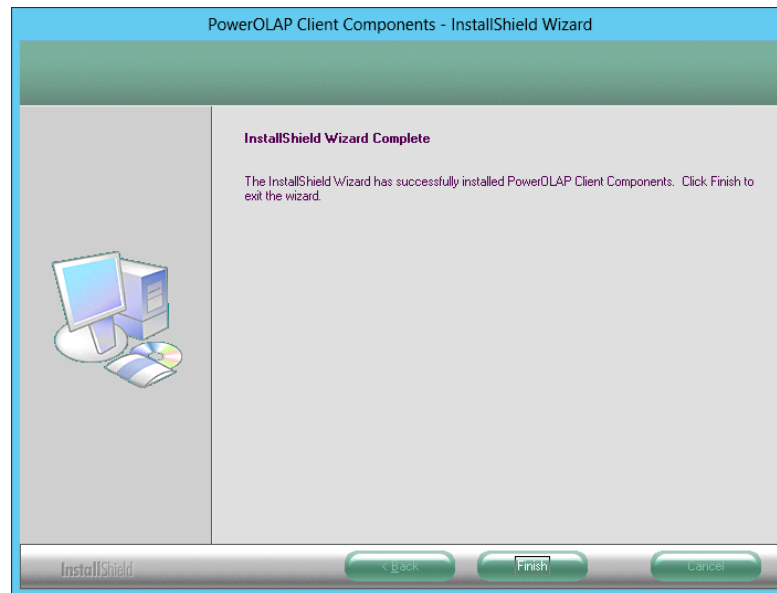
8. Click **Next** at the Choose Destination Location screen, shown below with default Destination Folder, i.e., **C:\Program Files\PowerOLAP**.



9. Click **Next** (preceding image)
10. Click **Install** to initialize installation (below).





11. Click **Finish** to complete the installation.




12. **Restart** the computer.

This completes the PowerOLAP® Designer Client installation. Next, activate the Designer Client software by entering a License ID and Password, as outlined in the succeeding topic.

2. 1.2 Register and Activate the Designer Software



3. Install and License the PowerOLAP® Reader and Writer Client

You must be logged in as a user with Administrator or equivalent rights to install PowerOLAP® Software.

- Please be sure that the PowerOLAP® application and Microsoft Excel application are closed before installing/uninstalling.

Note: Reader and Writer Clients must be connected to a PowerOLAP Server to work.

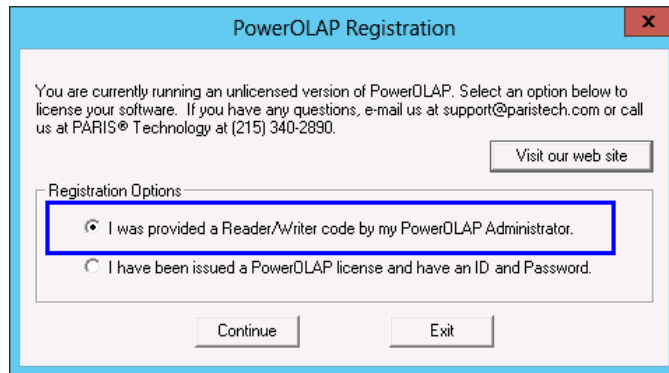
3.1.1 Reader and Writer Client Software Installation – Run the Setup.exe

IMPORTANT NOTE concerning Installation of the Reader and Writer Client: The initial steps for either the Reader or Writer Client are the same as the installation of the Designer Client. Therefore, please reference the preceding pages 1 - 11 through 1 - 15, (Steps 1 to 11), and then proceed as follows

12. Restart the computer.	This completes the PowerOLAP® Reader or Writer Client installation. Next, activate the Client software as outlined in the succeeding topic.
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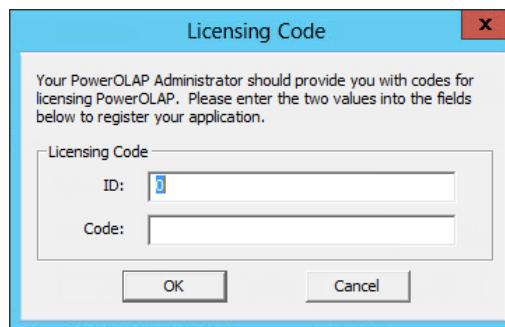
3.1.2 Register and Activate the Software

ACTION (You Do)	COMPUTER RESPONSE/Comments
Start the PowerOLAP® client from the Start menu (this image is shown in the middle of page 1 - 16)	<p>IMPORTANT: You must open the application as an administrator. To do this, right click on PowerOLAP® icon and select 'Run as administrator' option.</p> <p>The PowerOLAP Registration dialog appears.</p> <p>The process for registering the Reader or Writer Client begins with the selection of the top radio button—boxed in the screen image that follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>I was provided a Reader/Writer code by my PowerOLAP Administrator.</i>



1. Click **Continue**.

The **Licensing Code** dialog box appears as follows:



2. Enter a valid Reader or Writer **ID** and **Code** (reference your PowerOLAP licensing document)
3. Once the keys are entered, click **OK**.

The **Create New License** dialog box appears. This will require you to fill out some information before the installation can be completed.

<p>4. Completely fill out the form. Please be sure to enter the correct Company Name that has purchased the software, and—important—enter the correct email address to which you want the next set of licensing codes to be sent, for completion of the software activation</p> <p>5. After providing the required information, click on the Submit button.</p>	<p>After a moment, the License Codes dialog will pop up (next page).</p> <p>You will be sent, to the e-mail you entered in the above dialog, the License ID and Password that you will next use to license the software.</p>

<p>6. Enter the License ID and password e-mailed to you by PARIS Technologies.</p> <p>7. Click OK.</p>	<p>This completes the PowerOLAP® Reader or Writer software installation.</p>

NOTE: the following concerns Registration for PowerOLAP Server and Designer on a machine without Internet access.

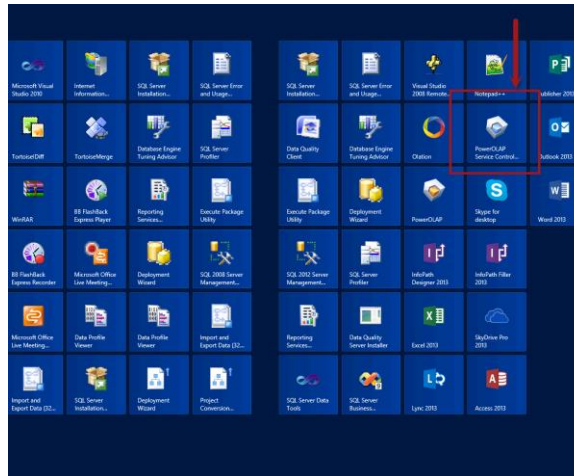
PowerOLAP® Server Offline Installation and License Registration

Follow the same steps for the PowerOLAP Server Installation that are described on p. 1 - 2 through 1 - 6, i.e., Section 1.1.1, steps 1 to 14.

NOTE—important: the next steps will require you to have access to the internet for browser/email—for example, via a smart phone—and be able to communicate information between the two machines (the “install machine,” i.e., on which the Server is to be registered and the connected machine).

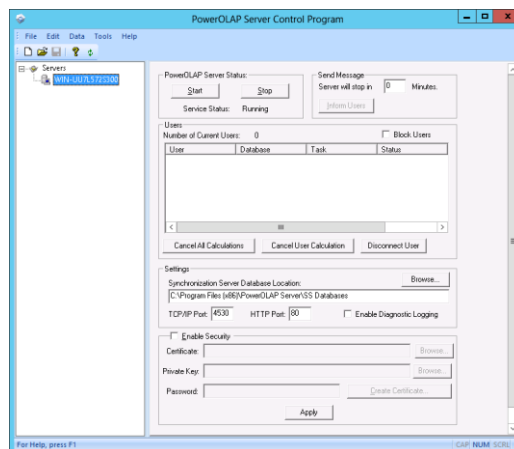
1. Start the PowerOLAP® Service Control program from the **Start** menu.

IMPORTANT: You must run/open the application as an administrator. To do this, right click on **PowerOLAP® Service Control Program** icon and select 'Run as administrator' option.



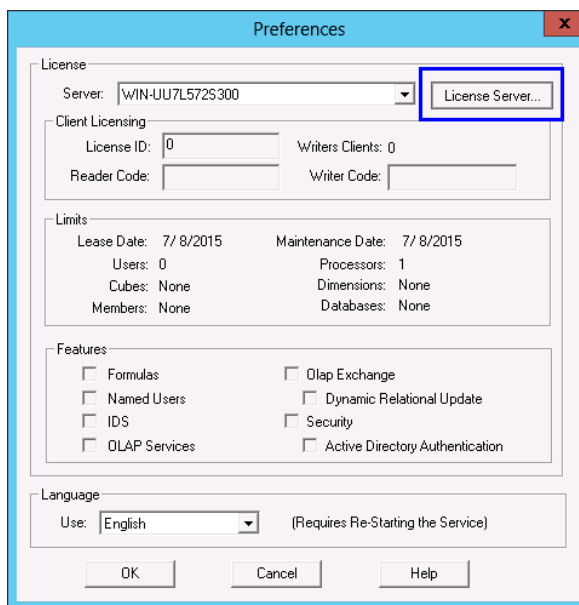
2. Start the **Server**.

The PowerOLAP Server status must be 'Running' to enable you to license it: click Start



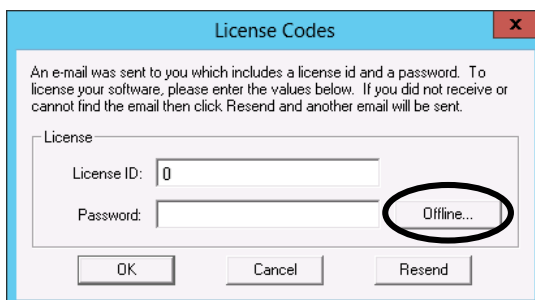
3. Go to **Edit** menu and select **Options** command.

The **Preferences** dialog box appears.



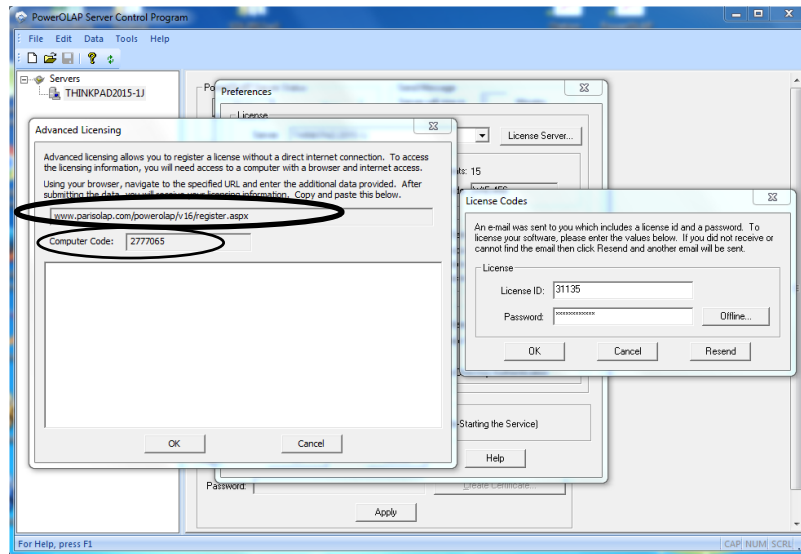
4. Click the **License Server** button.
(boxed button in the preceding image, top right)

The **License Codes** window will appear.



5. Enter a valid **License ID** and **Password**
(reference your PowerOLAP licensing document)
6. Once the keys are entered, click **Offline** (circled above).

A dialog box will appear—Advanced Licensing (see next image)



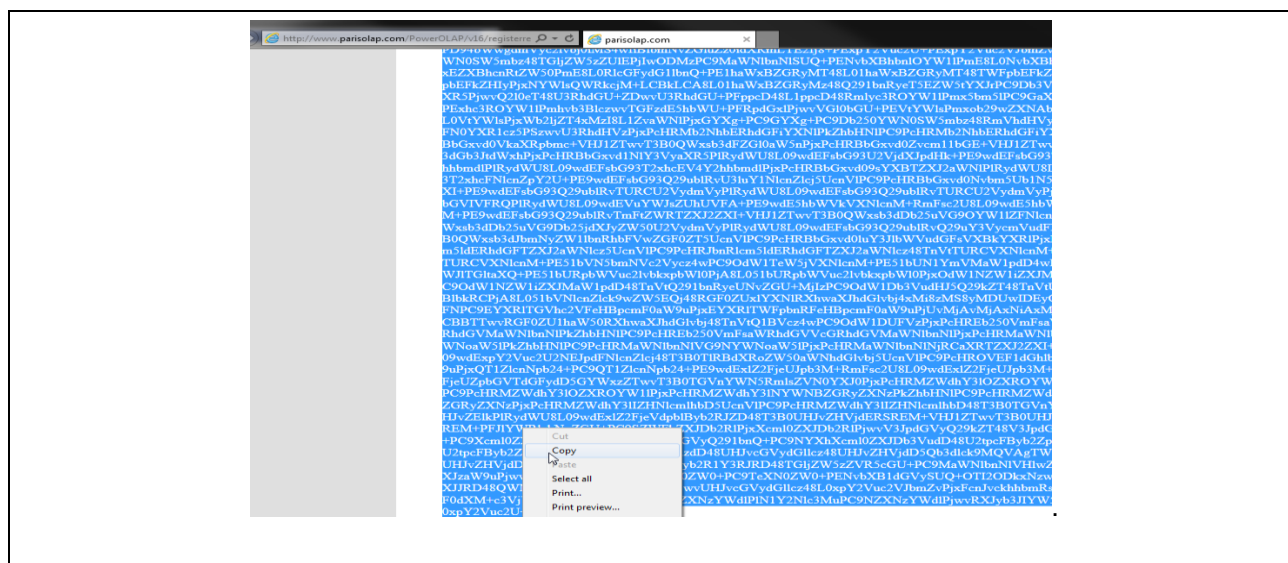
7. Copy the web site address that appears near the top of the Advanced Licensing dialog (circled in the preceding image) and go to it in a browser on your connected machine.
Note also the Computer Code below it (in the smaller circle, below it).

You will be taken to a page that looks like the below image.



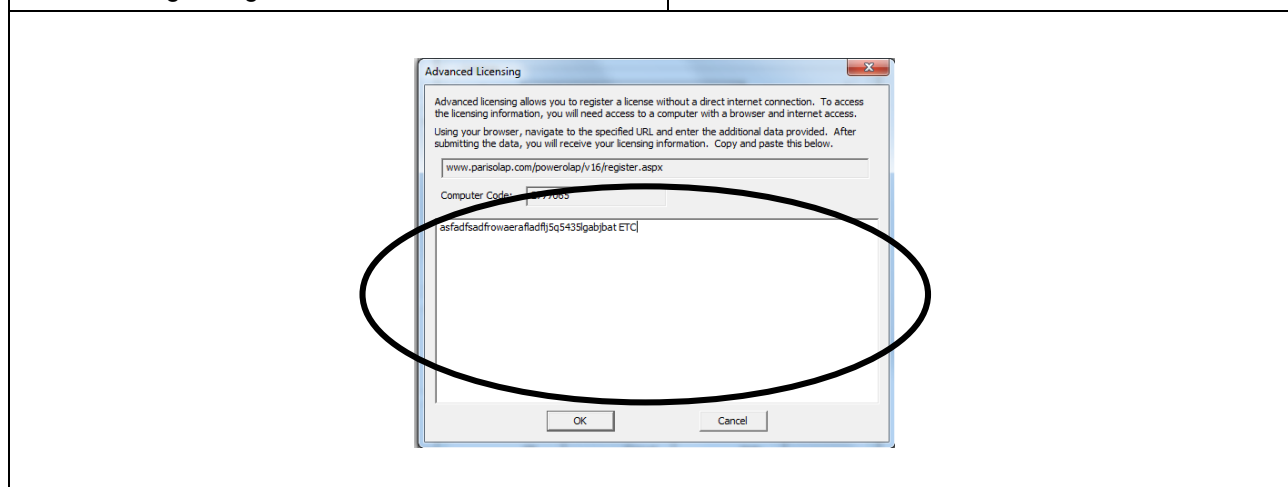
8. Again, enter your **License ID** and **Password** (reference your PowerOLAP licensing document—and the same as Step 5)
9. Also, enter the Computer Code into the text box named **Entry Code 1**
10. Click **Submit**

You will next see a web page with a long sequence of numbers and characters (see next image).



11. **Copy the text** and, by whatever means available, transmit it to the “non-connected” machine where you are installing the Server
12. **Paste it** into blank/white area of the Advanced Licensing dialog.

The image below shows the area in which to paste the long text--circled



13. Click **OK**
14. Click **OK** in the License Codes dialog (image right)

You will be prompted to stop and start the Server for the license to take effect





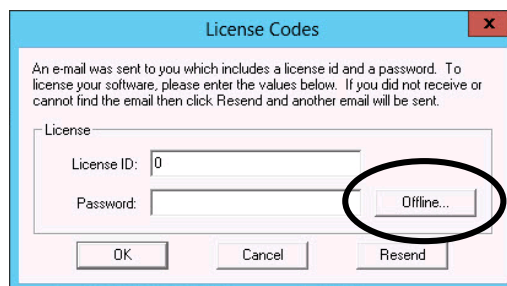
This completes the Offline PowerOLAP® Server installation and licensing.

PowerOLAP® Designer Offline Installation and License Registration

Follow the same steps for the PowerOLAP Designer Installation that are described on p. 1 - 10 thru p. 1 - 14, i.e., Section 2.1.1, steps 1 to 12.

NOTE—important: the next steps will require you to have access to the internet for browser/email—for example, via a smart phone—and be able to communicate information between the two machines (the “install machine,” i.e., on which the Designer is to be registered) and the connected machine

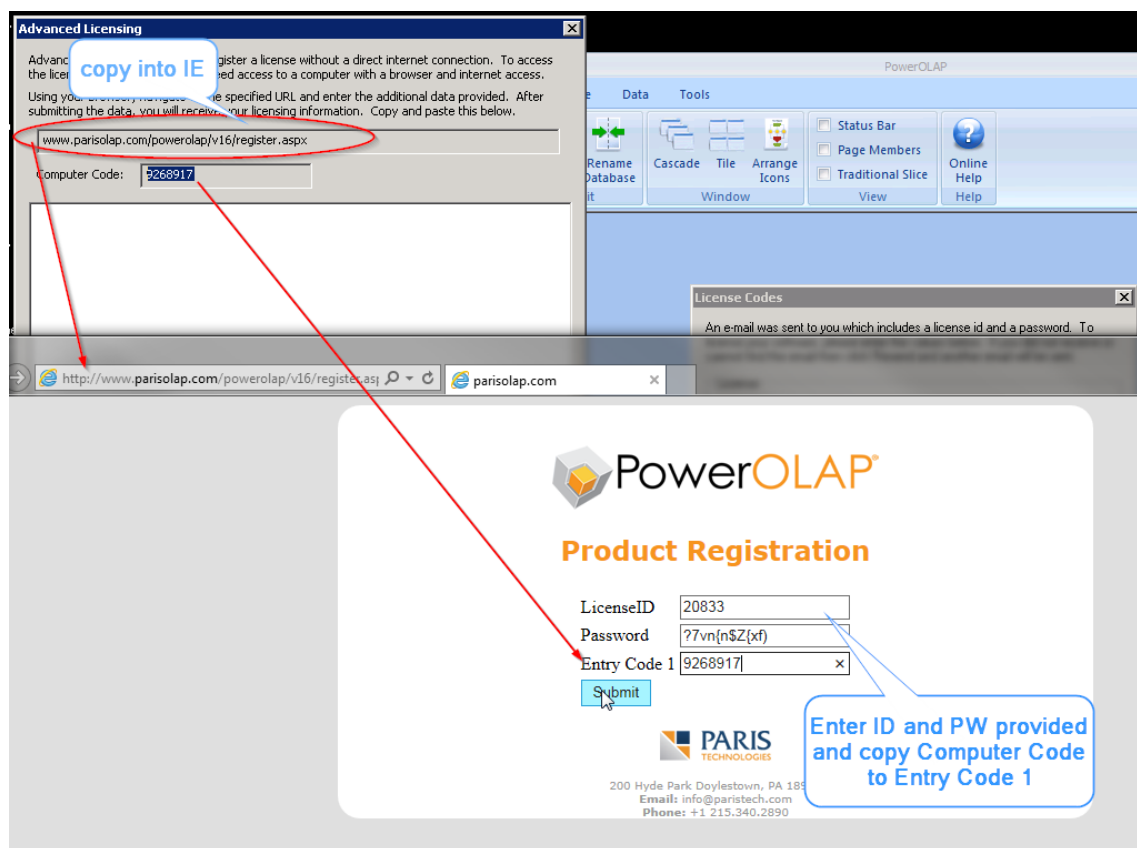

3. In the above dialog, enter the PowerOLAP **Designer License ID** and **Password** (reference your PowerOLAP licensing document)
4. Once the keys are entered, click **Offline** (circled above).

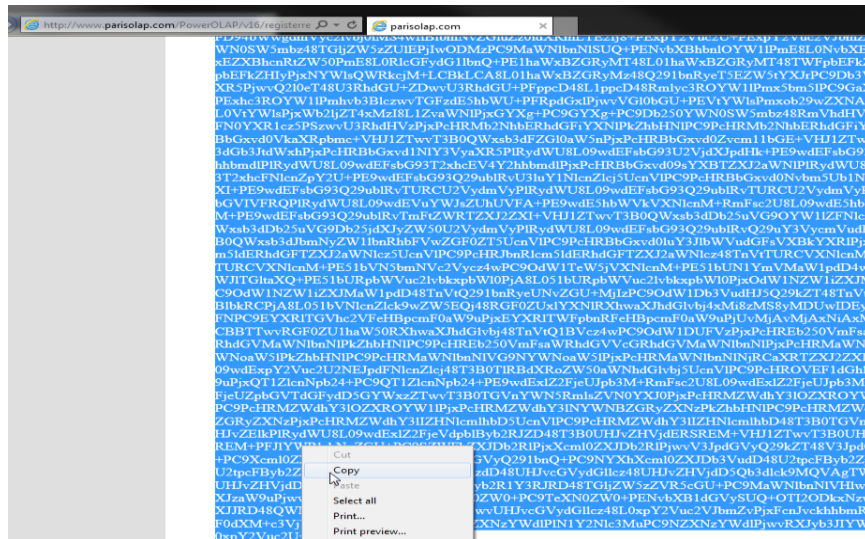
An Advanced Licensing dialog will appear on the machine where you are performing the offline (no internet connection) registration..

Note both the URL that appears and the Computer Code (shown at top left in the image below).

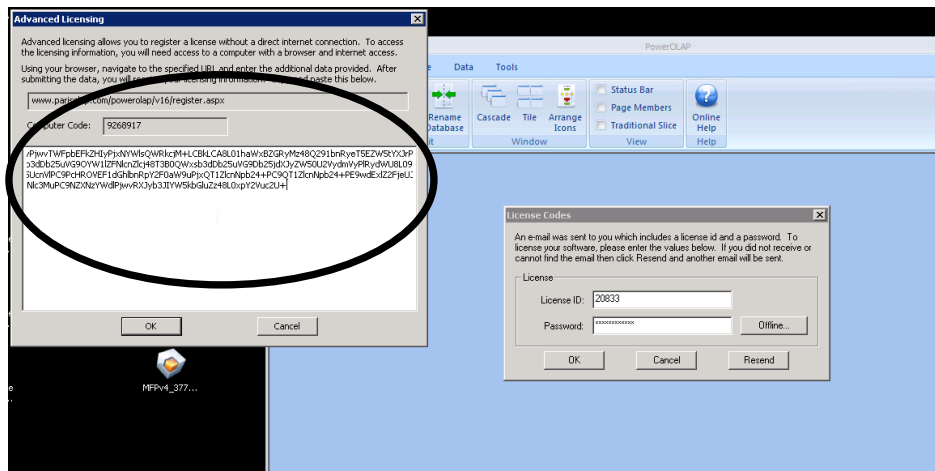


5. Copy the URL into the browser of the "connected" machine, and go to the resulting web page (see previous image – PowerOLAP Product Registration).
6. Enter the License ID and Password (same as Step 3) as well as the Entry Code (aka Computer Code that showed on the installation machine); hit **Submit**.

You will see a very long text string, like the one shown below, on the machine with internet access.



7. Copy the entire text string, and—by whatever means available to you—transmit it to the installation machine; paste it into the Advanced Licensing dialog, in the white space below Computer Code, as below (circled).



8. Click **OK** in Advanced Licensing dialog
9. Click **OK** in the License Codes box you originally opened

This completes the Offline installation and licensing of the PowerOLAP® Designer.
